

# FOUR WAYS TO BUY MODEL CAR RACING:

## How to order your personal copies of Model Car Racing magazine

### YOUR MAGAZINE

To see a sample of the magazine take a look at the free (really!) six articles and more from the current issue by clicking on "Sample Edition" on the top bar of the home page. You can also click on "Contents" and see the full listing of the additional articles that are in the paper and the Electronic Editions of Model Car Racing. This issue's "New Stuff", "Editorial" and "Ask The Experts" pages are also available, just click on the bars in the left box on the home page or on the "Contents". Also, six articles and more of issues #69 through to the current issue are accessible under the "Sample Issues" link on the top bar.

### **Best Quality Choice:**

Subscribe to both the paper edition & the "Electronic Edition (2) or the iPad Edition (3)

### **Best Value Choice:**

Subscribe to the Electronic Edition (2) and download and print only the articles you want to save.

### **(1.) THE PAPER MAGAZINE DELIVERED TO YOUR DOOR**

Subscribe to the paper edition mailed to your door by clicking under the top link "Subscribe" on the home page. The "paper" versions are just \$41.95 for six issues---you save \$6.75 compared to the newsstand price.

Issues 1 through 94 are sold out. We're sorry, but if we did not receive your subscription order by May 15, 2017 your first magazine will be issue #95, the September/October 2017 issue. Issue #95 should be available by August 15, 2017. You may still be able to find a copy of issues 92, 93 or 94 at some of the hobby dealers on our directory under "Dealers". No copies of any back issues of the paper version are available, however, about 36 back issues are available as Internet "Electronic Editions" (see #4 below).

NOTE: The \$41.95 subscription is ONLY for six copies of the paper edition. If you also want the Electronic Editions or the iPad or it is an additional \$29.99 for six issues. There are no "bundles" of paper and Electronic Editions or iPad Editions available. Only the Electronic Edition can be downloaded and printed.

### **(2.) INSTANT "ELECTRONIC EDITION" DELIVERY**

The new Electronic Edition of *Model Car Racing* is just \$29.99 for six issues and it has exactly the same articles and pages as the paper version but it can

be read on any device, a smart phone, tablet, PC or home computer. It is delivered as a page-turning format but it can also be downloaded as a pdf to read or to print in that format. This edition can only be enlarged by about 50-percent more than the size of the page of the paper edition pages. However, this is the only Internet or web version of the magazine that can be printed (by downloading the free pdf), it is interactive with links most of the suppliers and it can be searched. You can see a “Free Sample Edition” of the Electronic Edition with about one-third of the articles in a typical Electronic Edition of issues #90 and later by clicking on “Sample Issues” under the top bar.

Current Electronic Edition issues are available only as a \$29.99 subscription for 6 issues by clicking on “Subscribe”.

### **(3.) INSTANT "iPad EDITION" DELIVERY**

The electronic version of the magazine is also available as an interactive iPad Edition---we cannot process orders for iPad downloads---they must be ordered directly from the Apple iTunes store. The iPad Edition is interactive with direct one-click links to most of the products that are featured in that issue. The iPad Edition can also be enlarged on your screen to several-times the size of the page of paper or “Electronic Edition” pages. You can see a “Free Sample Edition” with about one-third of the articles in a typical iPad Edition on the iTunes website.

The iPad Edition of Model Car Racing cannot be downloaded for security purposes. There is currently no way to print the iPad edition but you can download and print the “Electronic Edition” (#2, above). Back issues starting with issue number 55 are available as Electronic Editions or as iPad Editions.

### **(4.) INSTANT BACK ISSUES AS "ELECTRONIC EDITION" DELIVERY**

We have no paper back issues of any Model Car Racing magazine, however, we have created all of the issues From issue number 91 back to the January/February 2011 number 55 issue as complete magazines in the new “Electronic Edition” format that is easier to access and easier for you archive than the paper version. To order go to [www.modelcarracingmag.com](http://www.modelcarracingmag.com) under the top bar click on right button “Back Issues” then scroll down to the issue you want and order. You can order as many different issues as you want by clicking on each one. Each issue is \$4.99 and the order is final---no refunds on any back issues. There are no “bundles” by year.

You can see a sample of about one-third of the articles (but a full list of the 60-pages of contents) of any of the issues back to number 69 under [www.modelcarracingmag.com](http://www.modelcarracingmag.com) under the top bar “Sample Issues”. Note that every paper edition of Model Car Racing has 24 black and white pages to keep the printing cost within reason. However, the later Electronic Editions (and the iPad editions) have 60 four-color pages. The earlier Electronic Editions may have 24 pages of black and white and some issues do not include the full-page ads. Only the current subscription Electronic Edition issues have the Interactive links

to products and sources.

You can view the contents pages of the full back issues of any of the issues back to number 69 on [www.modelcarracingmag.com](http://www.modelcarracingmag.com) under the "Sample Issue" top bar, then selecting the issue you want to see and looking at the contents page of that issue. There is a single link with the individual issue contents for issues 55 through 68. There is also a complete and searchable index of every issue's articles under "More Information" then "Modeling Resources" and click on Model Car Racing Magazine Index. You can also search for the listings of previous Track Plans and Race Car Tests under "Modeling Resources".

The articles, reports and how-to information is useful and timely because all of the cars and track are still available either at dealers or on eBay. The models reached their current level of perfection over a decade ago and the only significant mechanical change has been the separate motor pod (which can be retrofitted to virtually any 1/32 scale car).

All of the issues from 2011 through to issue number 91 are available now---over 36 complete issues with 1,800 pages of articles. There are no "bundles" by year---each issue can be purchased individually and quickly at [www.modelcarracingmag.com](http://www.modelcarracingmag.com) under the top right button "Back Issues".

**Internet Editions NOTE:** The iPad Edition and the Electronic Edition are only achieved electronically so you must save the link to access it. You can , however, archive the Electronic Edition by downloading each issue as a pdf.

**Paper Edition NOTE:** if you do opt for the Electronic Edition or the iPad Edition and you also want the paper edition, you must ALSO purchase the \$41.95 paper subscription---there are no "bundle" packages that include paper and the Electronic Edition or the iPad Edition. Note that the iPad version can be downloaded or printed.

We can only print the paper edition on about the 15<sup>th</sup> of every odd-numbered month so mail delivery can take add a week or more beyond the time of delivery of the Internet editions.

**To subscribe to the paper and/or internet versions of the magazine, you have three choices:**

Back issues issues #55 to #91 are available ONLY as Electronic Editions by clicking on "Back Issues" on the top bar (or ordering the iPad versions directly from Apple). We are sold out of all paper back issues and the special Limited Edition package that included the complete first year (2002) of Model Car Racing magazine (issues 1-6 only) and a collector's edition Cadillac Northstar Le Mans car, but a few and most paper back issues may be available from Electric Dreams ([www.electricdreams.com](http://www.electricdreams.com)).

Beginning October 5, 2007 we can no longer accept orders from Canadian or other foreign subscribers for the "paper" version of the magazine, but you can order the Electronic Editions ONLY version for \$29.99 from our secure web order service, click on "Subscribe" on top bar. The address you enter must match that on your credit card statement and you must type-in the state or province. New or renewal Canadian and other foreign subscriptions for the paper version will no longer be accepted. We are sorry, but the postal services in most countries are taking eight weeks and more to send the paper copy of the magazine when they deliver it at all. Only subscriptions for the United States will be accepted for the paper version of the magazine. We have a network of dealers in Canada, Europe, Japan and in Australia listed on this website (just click on the bar "Model Resources" at top of the home page, then on "Dealers") that will be pleased to supply the paper version of the magazine.
